The Job Access Transportation Program provides transportation on a demand basis that travels throughout Brooke and Hancock Counties via State Route 2 from Chester to Beech Bottom and Benwood to Moundsville within Marshall County for a small fee.

Routes are established for job accessibility, and buses stop only at pre-arranged areas within the City of Weirton limits. The buses connect with various other transportation services, including the Weirton Transit Corporation, Steel Valley RTA, and the Eastern Ohio Valley RTA, and specific employment shuttles are available on a contractual basis.

Call the Transportation Department at least 24 hours prior to the time you will need transportation. Discount passes are available.

American with Disabilities Act (ADA)

Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 and the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) provide comprehensive civil rights protection to individuals with disabilities in the areas of employment, public accommodations, state and local government services and programs, and telecommunications. Title II of the ADA states, in part, that:

No otherwise qualified disabled individual shall, solely by reason of such disability, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subject to discrimination in programs or activities sponsored by a public entity.

CHANGE, Inc. has adopted a complaint procedure to provide prompt and equitable resolution of complaints alleging any action prohibited by the U.S. Department of Justice regulations implementing Title II of the ADA. Any individual who believes that he/she or a specific class of individuals with disabilities has been subject to unlawful discrimination on the basis of that disability by CHANGE, Inc. or any of the CHANGE, Inc.'s contractors or suppliers may, by him or herself or by an authorized representative, file a written complaint.

Complaints or questions should be addressed to the Human Resources Director, who has been designated to coordinate compliance with Section 504.
