Family Medical Care operates the Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Program, which provides screening and diagnostic services such as clinical breast exams, pap smears, and mammograms free of charge to women who qualify.

SERVICES

This program only screens for breast and cervical cancers, however, patients are eligible for free screenings every year until they no longer meet eligibility requirements. If diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer, the patient is eligible for Medicaid under the Medicaid Treatment Act established in 2001., and will be enrolled by the BCCSP Coordinator and the surgeon who diagnosed the disease. Hysterectomies are not covered under this program

COUNTIES SERVED

This is a federal program, therefore there are no county or state boundaries. However, further diagnostic treatment for out-of-state patients is not covered.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the program, women must be between the ages of 25-64 for an annual pap smear, and 50-64 for an annual mammogram, and must meet income guidelines.

HOW TO RECEIVE SERVICE

Call Family Medical Care to see if you qualify. Then make an appointment for a screening. The BCCSP Coordinator or Nurse will complete the necessary paperwork during the appointment.
